



Smoking Policy

In accordance with safeguarding and welfare requirements Health and Social Care Standards children should be cared for in a safe, hygienic and smoke-free environment.

Staff, parents/carers and visitors are not permitted to smoke or vape anywhere within the building or surrounding premises.

We display no smoking signs as a polite reminder of our no smoking environment.

Any staff who wish to smoke or vape should do so only when they are on a lunch break and have removed themselves from the premises and are not in sight of the setting.

All staff who wish to smoke or vape should wash their hands and make an effort to be free from the smell of smoke before returning to playrooms.

A change of clothes is suggested for smoking or vaping in.

Staff are not permitted to have any smoking materials on their person whilst in the playrooms.

- Cigarettes,
- Lighters,
- Matches
- Vapes

Any member of staff who is caught smoking or vaping on site will be dealt with in accordance to the Disciplinary Procedure.

Any parent/carer or Visitor caught smoking or vaping on site will be asked to leave, if caught on several occasions, childcare may be revoked.
